

North South Campus Access Route

The University has created a North-South Campus Access Route, which is designed to provide a step free route across campus for disabled staff members or students, or any other staff member or student with access needs, for examples those needing access with pushchairs. This route, shown on all campus maps, is open to all staff and students during the University's main opening times.

However, out of hours and at weekends, students and staff requiring access to this route will need to use a key fob (an electric unlocking device) on some doors.

The key fob may also be used to allow level access to other areas of the University outside of standard hours.
